#### CAPACITY BUILDING

The *BuildMyECECareer.com* website and related digital marketing campaign enters its 2nd quarter of the yearlong early childhood workforce recruitment campaign efforts. Local video creation is underway to ensure that the digital marketing campaign is as engaging as possible. One of the biggest achievement of paid awareness efforts is the consistently growing direct traffic to the page with over-five-minutes average sessions. We have delivered a total of:

- o **766,360** impressions
- o 2,417 ad clicks
- 2,276 sessions to the landing page

#### **EXPANSION**

JI staff numbers are growing with the hiring two Early Childhood Mental Health (ECMH) Practitioners to address the increasing demand for mental health supports at ECE centers and two Career Navigators to address the early childhood workforce crisis.

#### **PARTNERSHIP**

JI/AFK selected nine early childhood programs to participate in our Wages + Stages Workforce Program to address El Paso County's workforce crisis. Nine programs will receive the Wages + Stages Hiring Toolkit, monthly community-based training for newly hired staff, access to the Wages + Stages Leadership Development Series, Professional Learning Community meetings, social media connection group for networking and peer support, and staff opening monitoring and matching:

#### ADDITIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Emerging & Expanding (E&E) Grant Opportunity: El Paso County has \$1.2M in applications under review and the State closed the E&E grant on Nov. 1st to organize current applications. Emerging and Expanding Grant E&E funds allow for the creation of new early childhood programs, or expansion of the number of spots within an existing program.

#### CAPACITY BUILDING

JI is pursuing additional **grant funds** for data management supports as well as the provision of Care Coordination services for non-Medicaid eligible families that need ongoing supports beyond the ISST process.

## **PARTNERSHIP**

JI recently issued an *Request for Proposal (RFP)* to subcontract for CYDC for juvenile detention screening, assessment, care coordination, and community supervision services. Applications were submitted and an award will be announced Friday, December 10th, with a start date of January 1, 2022.

#### **ADDITIONAL HIGHLIGHTS**

- To date, MTR numbers have gradually increased with 21 new cases (52 total cases for the year). This increase is a direct result of students returning to school and increased usage of illegal substances and mental health struggles in the youth population.

## **EXPANSION**

Il's **NEW Partner Recruiter** is tasked with expanding high fidelity wraparound services in the Pikes Peak Region. This position will work to expand the number of available wraparound agencies, work collaboratively to certify facilitators, and expand the availability of wraparound slots across our community.

JI is continuing its **grant pursuit for a Family Engagement Coach** position to convene and re-engage the EC Council's Family Support + Education Subcommittee to better meet the needs and provide linkages between families and parenting resources.
