# HEALTH + WELL-BEING PROJECT

**Health + Well-Being** aims to support and enhance healthy practices and social/emotional and behavioral support for community organizations and families.

### UPDATES | EMBEDDED EARLY CHILDHOOD MENTAL HEALTH CONSULTATION (E-ECMHC):

- A sister site of one of the embedded programs reached out with an urgent request to support three children with disruptive behaviors, all who were at risk of suspension/expulsion. These children and their teachers have been added to the active caseload and work began this month to support them.
- Twenty-four (24) staff attended one professional development workshop.
- Relationships with center staff continue to strengthen, as shown by the number of requests for support.
- Goals for many of the child-focused cases are being met, and several cases are being closed.

#### PYRAMID COLORADO

The **Pyramid Community Leadership Team** met this month and continued to strategize how to get additional early childhood staff trained in the Pyramid Colorado Model. The Pyramid Coordinator for Healthy Child Care Colorado attended the meeting and remarked that the work of this team is innovative and a great model for communities to follow.

### FAMILY, FRIEND + NEIGHBOR (FFN) PROGRAMING: THE COLORADO HEALTH FOUNDATION

• **Playgroups:** These play-based groups bring music, movement, literacy and school readiness activities to young children and their caregivers. **In December, a holiday-themed playgroup was held with 32 adults and 52 children, the largest attendance to date.** Relationships between adults participants continue to strengthen, with friendships forming, and children interacting more with each other. A larger number of FFNs are attending each session.

## QUALITY INITIATIVES PROJECT INTEGRATED WITH PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

**Quality Initiatives (QI)** focus on coaching, outreach, supports, resources/assets, and professional development to enhance quality in early care and education (ECE) programs. Child Care Resource & Referral (CCR&R) work focuses on outreach to update and support licensed ECE programs, increase capacity for licensed ECE programs, and provide resources and referrals for parents/families for ECE programs. Professional Development (PD) is integrated throughout QI and CCR&R.

### **QI UPDATES**

#### • Program Outreach

- JI Outreach continues to educate providers on the benefits of the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP).
   Foundations Program Director has spoken with four providers about the benefits CCCAP. JI will be working with a sub-contractor starting January 2023, who will provide direct business consultation around the benefits of CCCAP and how to stack that with UPK funding. We are starting to see an increase in the level of interest from providers as the rates for Universal Pre-K have been released.
- Festival of Lights Gospel Extravaganza at the City Auditorium
- Promotion of the Simple Gift Playgroup and Simple Gift Scholars Training
- Ongoing outreach about Pikes Peak Early Childhood website
- One early childhood provider is engaged with the QI Navigator to increase from a Level 1 to a Level 2 rating.
- Colorado Shines Quality Improvement Grant
  Four programs signed MOUs for coaching in December.
- Emerging + Expanding Child Care Grant Opened January 23rd
  Two El Paso County programs have applied so far.

### PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT UPDATES

- Workforce Development: Expanding Quality for Infants and Toddlers (EQIT) and Compassion Fatigue
- **ECE Career Navigator supports** include career pathways, Early Childhood Teacher qualification, Director qualification, Professional Development Information System (PDIS) ECE Credential and general technical support, Child Development Associate (CDA) assistance, and scholarships.
