Shouldn't he be talking by now?

Your child's early years matter.

Are you concerned about the way your child speaks, plays, or interacts with others?

Your child's early years are essential to his or her future learning and development, making it very important to **speak up** if you feel your child is missing developmental milestones or if you have general concerns about your child's development.

For a *FREE Early Intervention Evaluation*, call The Resource Exchange (TRE). This play-based screening will help determine if your child is reaching developmental milestones. If your child needs support, your child may qualify for free services.

IF YOUR CHILD IS 3 - 5 YEARS OLD:

For a *FREE Child Find Screening*, call your home school district Child Find office. This play-based screening will determine if your child may have a delay in development that may interfere with learning. If the screening shows your child may need support in one or more areas, an evaluation may be completed and your child may receive free services within a school district preschool.
