UPK Payment Schedule

UPK payments will be distributed to providers in advance on a monthly basis, August through May. In August, you will receive a startup payment based on your matches from the first three rounds of matching. A family must have accepted their match with your program by July 9th to be included in the startup payment. Payments through the school year will be based on confirmed enrollments on the 15th of the prior month. The general payment schedule will be as follows:

- **15th of the prior month** deadline for providers to confirm a child is enrolled at their site for inclusion in the next payment.
- 8th of the payment month payment distributed (ACH transfer) to providers based on prior month's enrollments.

Additional information for children enrolled after July 9, 2023, is coming soon. We welcome your feedback as we continue working with the Department to finalize the payment processes.

Next Steps

The Department is evaluating additional hour eligibility for families who meet qualifying factors. Families will be notified soon after the July 9th enrollment deadline of their final UPK award. As a reminder, payment amount varies based on your LCO catchment area, <u>you can review the published school-year UPK rates here.</u>

SECTION B: VERIFY UPK PROGRAM SCHEDULES

The startup payment for UPK 2023-24 school year (August 1, 2023-May 31, 2024) will be distributed on August 1, 2023. To ensure you receive the correct payment based on your preschoolers' eligibility, the following section will ask questions to confirm UPK program schedules at your site.

UPK programs are defined by <u>total hours per week</u> and may differ from your site's definition of part time, half time, full time, or before/after care hours. The standard amount of UPK funding for 4-year-olds covers 15 hours per week, which is the UPK definition of half day. Children who attend less than 15 hours per week (UPK part-time) will receive funding for 10 hours. Some children <u>may</u> be eligible for additional hours if enrolled in a full day or extended day program if they meet <u>qualifying factors</u>.
