

DATA: 7/1/23 - 11/30/23

Probation Youth: 30 youth, closed out

- 100% No New Charges, 100% No Failure to Appear, 97% Positive or Neutral

Pre-Adjudicated: 159 youth, closed out

- 87% No New Charges, 96% No Failure to Appear, 95% Positive or Neutral Closeouts

21 E-ISSTs, referrals picking back up – working with DHS for 48-hour turnaround

MTR Updates

MTR provides early intervention for youth identified through municipal and truancy court settings with options for deferred sentences.

Program Highlights as of 7/1/23-11/30/23:

20 youth open in YESS program, 7 - ISST Truancy Court

33 Fountain Municipal cases.

74 Care Coordination (includes Fountain)

4th cohort of Another Pathway (Strengthening Families, an evidence-based youth/parent 5-week class.) Begins in JANUARY! 3 adults & 5 youth registered so far.

- Update... youth passed 4/4 GED tests and was rewarded with a gift card for their progress. – completed all 4 and closed out!
- Youth getting connected with Dale House for transitional services programming!

Consider least restrictive services/placement; family and youth voice and choice throughout all phases; shared decision making and responsibility among parties; trauma-informed and responsive.

PARTNER UPDATES:

DHS

Focusing on implementation for training and visioning around prevention and crisis stabilization.

- Initial Contact Prevention Specialist (hotline/for some families that do not meet criteria to screen in)
- Prevention Specialist (Intake)
- Court Liaison (adolescent) - this adds to the two leads currently in court for prevention purposes - this added position equals a total of three court focused caseworkers for early intervention/prevention)
- New - Incarcerated Parent Liaison to support, work with jails and prisons for family time in secure facilities.

PARTNER UPDATES:

JUVENILE PROBATION

- Please instruct youth and families to report in-person to the Probation Department immediately following sentencing. They will be assigned a Probation Officer and will be provided with an intake appointment the same day. This is a department wide effort to immediately connect clients with officers and to get services and interventions started.
- We are hiring a Probation Supervisor! The posting will be active from January 5th to January 15th, 2024. Initial interviews will be held January 22nd-23rd.


