Approval of November Minutes	All Approved
UPK Updates	 Workforce shortages and retention issues remain a primary concern, with efforts underway to address them. Providers are encouraged to make data-driven decisions about filling UPK seats and managing their business models. Issues with CCAP (Child Care Assistance Program) sign-ups were addressed, and support mechanisms were discussed for providers facing challenges. Noreen shared that El Paso County is actively working on a dual enrollment report from CDEC. This report aims to benefit families and help identify how CCAP funds are being allocated.
Council Committee	 Goals and objectives for proposed committees were reviewed. Members were invited to sign up for the Legislation & Public Policy, and the Communications & Membership Committee. A task force on quality standards was proposed and more information will be provided after the new year. Members were encouraged to reach out to Shay or Kelly if interested in the Workforce & Mental Health Committee liaison roles.
Executive Committee Membership	 Members explored the idea of expanding the Executive Committee to enhance governance, improve communication, and streamline decision-making. Act as a hub for directing legislative and policy initiatives. Develop a reporting structure to track progress on strategic objectives. A proposal on the committee's composition will be presented.
